Registering Your Group with ASA SQ Youth

1. Register as an official student club through the office of campus life on your campus.
2. When registering your group on your campus - identify your group with ASA regardless of local name. E.g. ASA@ [insert university name].
3. Register with ASA SQ Youth through the application process and [online](#).
4. Submit organisation constitution and email it to [Joseph Khabbaz](#), a template constitution is available for [download](#).

What ASA SQ Youth Will Expect of You and Your Campus Group

1. Pray regularly, with your leadership team for your campus and students.
2. Read, understand and agree to the ten campus ministry essentials (WORDS) as listed in the Word On Campus book as well as be in harmony with beliefs and practices of the SDA Church as a representative organisation of the Adventist church on campus.
3. Printed materials should be branded with [ASA logo](#). May also have a local logo.
4. Suggested Facebook presence and or local web site for your group. Link your group to the ASA SQ Youth [Facebook page](#).
5. List group signatories and campus constitution and by-laws on the FB page or web site.
6. Should have a designated person assigned to manage internet sites and postings.
7. Coordinate ministry efforts and events with local churches, conferences, unions and other ASA in the region.
8. Communicate ASA news and events to Associate Youth Director (Pr. Joseph Khabbaz) for publication on the monthly ASA SQ Youth eLetter - ASA SQ Youth TODAY.
9. Recommended participation in at least one inter-collegiate function during the school year.
10. Have a least one student to attend one annual ASA SQ Youth function or event.

How ASA SQ Youth Can Benefit Your Group

1. ASA SQ Youth offers a network with all other SDA campus ministry organisations on college and university campuses throughout Australia.
2. Certifies your group with official recognition as a Seventh-day Adventist campus ministry group on your campus providing legal status through the Seventh-day Adventist church.
3. Connects your group with all the best resources, training, mentoring and networking via Adventist Students Association. Together we are stronger!
4. Funding is set aside every year for launching new campus ministry groups. We have up to \$200 per semester available for every new ASA SQ Youth chapter. Funds must be used for food and expenses in locating and gathering a group together for the purpose of launching a new ASA chapter.
